Spam & Fraud Alert: That's not your priest

Please be aware that some emails are being sent from scammers claiming to be our bishop, priests or office staff. Names are being pulled from parish and Diocesan websites to create fake email (often Gmail) accounts. There have also been fake text messages. You will notice the email address may have some correct information, though in an unfamiliar form with additional characters, numbers or periods. Most will ask you to contact them or send information. If you are in doubt, contact the person the email is claiming to be from using an alternate contact method. **Please do not reply to any suspicious emails.** Also note: At no time will our bishop, priests, deacons, religious or Diocesan staff contact you seeking Google Play cards, iTunes cards or any other form of personal financial assistance.
