1. **Central Fund Loan** – for parishes with out-standing loans.
2. **Repairs & Maintenance** – may be directed to the parish's Repairs & Maintenance savings account held within the Central Fund.
3. **Operations/Program/Savings** – surplus funds may be used to support 2026 parish programs, operational needs, or existing operational deficits.
4. **Other Parishes** – surplus funds may be directed to support other parishes in meeting their TIA campaign goals.
5. **Indigenous Reconciliation Fund** – surplus funds may be allocated to the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund.
